This aircraft offers impressive speed and range for an aircraft in its class. It is perfectly designed for long-distance travel, whether for a leisure getaway or an important business trip.

The cabin interior, accessible via the TB's signature butterfly doors, offers generous space with four leather seats. The seats show slight signs of wear due to age, as visible in the photos. The instrument panel is equipped with a Garmin GNS530 and a KFC150 autopilot, a highly regarded configuration. The aircraft also benefits from a modern paint job.

The propeller was overhauled during the last annual inspection in September 2024, making this aircraft ready to fly.
